



Welcoming All Teams to Saltburn
for our
25th Anniversary
Day of Dance
on Saturday 29th June 2024

We are delighted that you will be joining us on this special occasion and, from your feedback, we have put together the following plan.

We will be meeting on the seafront top promenade at the Lookout - see the attached map for the location on the top promenade - No 1. This area is much bigger than the Station portico and will accommodate the teams more easily for the all team showcases. It would be great if you can meet us there around 10.15 to start the showcase at 10.30, but don't worry if you are delayed at all, just join us when you arrive.

The attached schedule shows where we have planned for you to dance. Hopefully these places and timings will work well for you and be where you will have good audiences. We have put several teams together so that you aren't rushing between dances; the end times are flexible in case you wish to finish earlier or continue dancing.

Other than the showcases and two set dance locations, please feel free to take time out or move on to explore any of the alternative dance spots around the town or beach promenade. The suggested alternative dance spots are marked with an A on the map.

We do have permission from the Council for teams to dance anywhere, but please try not to block pathways or cause obstructions.

There is plenty of free parking in Saltburn - along the top seafront promenade or in streets in the town. Everywhere can be busy, especially if it is a bright, sunny day. There is a large car park on the lower seafront, shown on the map. Again it can get busy.

We will be asking groups of teams to take an RNLI Charity bucket with them to collect any public donations. This is an extremely relevant cause given our seaside location, with an RNLI post in nearby Redcar and RNLI lifeguards regularly patrolling Saltburn beach.

If you need refreshments, there are plenty of small pubs and cafes about in the town plus a Sainsbury's near the Station portico and bakery shops selling sandwiches etc.

On the lower promenade there are plenty of fish and chip options, plus a pasty shop - but if you want sandwiches then it would be best to get these before heading down to the beach area.

The attached map will hopefully provide all the information you need, there are free public toilets at the Station portico and near to the Cliff Lift bottom exit on the lower promenade, and in the lower promenade car park- again marked on the map

There are plenty of pubs and micro pubs in the town, including the Back Alex (Alexander Vaults - No 9)- which is always welcoming and has a small area for dancing.

On the lower promenade there is the Ship Inn - near dance spot No 6.

At the top of Hazel Grove, you will find Saltburn House - No 8 - which has a public bar and you are welcome to dance outside in their grounds or opposite on the promenade.

After the final showcase dance, back at the Lookout, Jet Set will be heading into the Marine Hotel for a well earned beverage - please join us if you can! The Marine will also be used as a wet weather venue if needed.
